
Dear Resident,

STREET TREE PRUNING

The Town would like to advise that during the months of November and December, arborist contractors will be conducting verge tree pruning in your area. This is part of the Town wide uplift program.

This program ensures pedestrians and cyclists using footpaths have safe access ways and involves the pruning of low hanging street tree branches over footpaths, driveways and verges to a minimum clearance height of 2.5 metres, where possible. It also ensures the safe passage of vehicles (including trucks) on roads and low hanging branches over streets will be pruned to a height of 4.5 metres, where possible.

Arborists will assess the most appropriate amount to be pruned based on the individual requirements of each tree. Please note that there will not be any reduction pruning from private property as per the Town's policy.



Works of this nature will involve the use of trucks, chainsaws, pole saws, blowers and chipper machinery. Contractors will operate between the hours of 7am and 5pm on weekdays and endeavour to keep disruptions to a minimum.

Please observe the safety signage and keep out of their work zones. If possible, park vehicles in driveways and out from underneath trees to allow contractors adequate access to conduct the works.

Thank you for your understanding while the Town works to improve the safety of our streetscapes.
